What is World Heritage? Its Conservation and Sustainable Use

Background

During the Public Hearings held in many municipalities of Zacatecas between April and May of 2019, by the Regional World Heritage Institute in Zacatecas (IRPMZ), the concern and need of students, teachers, cultural managers, municipal authorities and public inhabitants in general, training on the conservation and use of World Heritage in the Cultural Route of the Camino Real de Tierra Adentro, for development in the communities and the region.

Objective

Implement an online workshop on the basic themes of World Heritage, among others those related to the Cultural Route of the Camino Real de Tierra Adentro, to sensitize and develop regional capacities, for the knowledge and appropriation of concepts such as World Heritage, under the scheme of the sustainability.

Aimed at

50 to 60 people sensitized and trained for the conservation of the World Heritage and its sustainable use.

Content Proposal

The proposed topics are:

1. The 1972 Convention
2. Basic Documents of UNESCO and of Advisory Bodies
3. The World Cultural and Natural Heritage
4. Preparation of collective work proposals (institutions, communities and stakeholders) around the conservation and sustainable use of World Heritage in the environment.

There will be 16 sessions on digital platform, each with a duration of four hours, for a total of 64 hours. Throughout each month, participants will cover 9 h. of field work, for a total of 36 h. The final result will be reflected in 100 h. of work.
